Parking

- Accessible parking spaces clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Designated accessible parking spaces been provided within 100' 0" (30m) of an accessible entrance
- Parking surface smooth and flat
- Where curbs or changes in level occur in the pedestrian route, accessible curb cuts been provided

Walkway

- All pedestrian routes to each accessible entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Smooth surface to provide easy access by wheelchair
- Flat grade or gradual slope
- Main access routes clear of obstacles such as snow, construction, etc.
- Obstructions and hazards been eliminated from normal pedestrian routes
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting along walkway
- All exterior accessible pedestrian route(s) or paths at least 3'-6' (1065mm) wide
- Accessible curb cuts or ramps been provided wherever there is a change in level among pedestrian routes

Entrance

- All signage indicating entrance has been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- Doorway equipped with an automatic button, automatic slide, or easy open features
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair, or scooter users
- Ramp has smooth non-slip surface, grade ratio 1:12

- Entrance clear of obstacles such as shoes, snow, mats, etc.
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting at the entrance
- Entrance has sufficient lighting
- Exterior ramps and stairs have a non-slip finish

Main Facility

- Smooth/non slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles such as mats, seating, displays, etc.
- Strong contrast/lighting throughout the facility
- Accessible signage/information
- Accessible elevator access to multilevel areas
- Waiting areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters

Washrooms

- Washroom entrance equipped with easy open/automatic door
- Accessible signage identifying Male/Female washrooms
- Light switches, paper towel, hand dryer and soap dispensers with automatic lower level access
- Lever or automatic taps
- Space under sinks and counter tops for wheelchair access
- Washrooms clear of obstacles such as garbage cans, cleaning supplies etc.
- Sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Coat hooks have lower level access
- Wall table
- Towel dispenser with no garbage can underneath them
- Available family, unisex, male and female washrooms with slightly different accessibility features

Parking

- City parking on street
- No designated accessible parking spaces nearby

Walkway

- Walkway to / from elevator is approximately 2 inches; uneven in one place

Entrance

- Accessible entrance on Johnson Street
- Elevator access from ground level to sanctuary
- To call elevator requires a key

Main Facility

- No designated wheelchair seating; limited space at front far sides of sanctuary

Washrooms

- Accessible washrooms
- Wide door frame, very narrow threshold
- Washroom door is very light, regular knob
- Slight slope into washroom

Parking

- Accessible free parking

Walkway

- Ramp at least 3 feet, 6 inches wide

Entrance

- Ramp is at least 30 feet and slightly steep
- Accessible front entrance with automatic doors

Main Facility

- Aisles narrow in some places
- Computer lab has adaptive hardware and software for easier access to the internet for people with disabilities
- TTY available for use
- Good colour contrast throughout facility

Washrooms

- Accessible individual washrooms

Parking

- 2 designated accessible parking spaces
- Parking surface smooth and flat

Walkway

- Smooth and wide surface
- Gradual slope and accessible curb cuts
- Entrance
- Double doors, automatic slide

Main Facility

- Adjustable height desk available
- Self check-out high but wheel under
- At least 2 low computer stations
- E-books and audio books available
- Study rooms - wide doors, no threshold with wheel under tables

Outside courtyard / reading room

- Wide door, low threshold, no automatic buttons
- Concrete flooring, some grass

Washrooms

- Accessible washrooms
- 2 stalls available (1 male, 1 female)

Washroom (family)

- Accessible washroom

Parking

- 1 accessible parking space
- Metered parking in lot and underground (6 feet, 4 inch clearance)
- Parking surface smooth by sloped

Walkway

- Accessible entrance ramp meets up with parking lot (no walkway)
- Ramp at least 3 ft. 6 in. wide

Entrance

- Automatic slide doors, double doors
- Wide doors, low threshold
- Ramp is at least 30 ft., and slightly steep

Elevator

- Spacious, handrails
- Buttons high, no Braille

Main Facility

- 2 lowered service counters
- Lounge area provides access for wheelchairs and scooters
- Wheel under desks
- Computer database /catalogue and self-checkout very high
- Aisles narrow in some places
- Accessible computer - at wheel under table
- E-books, large print books available

Washrooms (1st and 3rd floors)

- Accessible washrooms (stalls)
- No automatic button on door

Washroom (2nd floor)

- Accessible washroom
- Lever handle on door

Parking

- 4 accessible parking spaces
- Parking surface smooth and flat

Walkway

- Smooth surface with a gradual slope

Entrance

- Double automatic sliding doors
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchairs and scooters

Main Facility

- Accessible service counters
- Accessible elevator to lower level (low threshold)
- Accessible computer available
- Self-checkout has very high touch screen (not wheel under)
- Accessible computer training room
- 2 meeting rooms on main level, large open space

Washrooms

- Accessible washrooms

Parking

- 3 accessible parking spaces

Entrance

- Double automatic sliding doors
- Wide door frame, low threshold

Main Facility

- Desks are open to wheel under to fill out paperwork
- Accessible service counter for Records
- Accessible service counter at side of Info / Report Incidents desk
- Waiting area for wheelchairs / scooters
- Debit terminal accessible on lower Records counter
- Accessible elevator

Interview Room

- Located on main level
- Very low threshold
- Can wheel under table

Community Room

- Typically used for press releases / community events
- Spacious with very low threshold
- Wheel under tables

Washrooms

- 3 single unisex accessible washrooms

Parking

- Accessible parking spaces clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Designated accessible parking spaces been provided within 100'-0" (30m) of an accessible entrance
- A safe, clearly marked accessible pedestrian route from the designated parking area to an accessible building entrance or elevator lobby
- Parking surface smooth and flat
- Parking area and route has sufficient lighting

Walkway

- All building and route signage been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- All pedestrian routes to each accessible entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Smooth surface to provide easy access by wheelchair
- Gradual slope
- Main access routes clear of obstacles such as snow, and construction
- Obstructions and hazards been eliminated from normal pedestrian routes
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting along walkway
- Flat surface throughout, no change in level along pedestrian routes

Entrance

- All signage indicating entrance has been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- All signage indicating entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Doorway equipped with an automatic button, automatic slide, or easy open features
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair, or scooter users
- Entrance clear of obstacles such as shoes, snow and mats
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting at the entrance
- Entrance has sufficient lighting

Main Facility

- Smooth/non slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles such as mats, seating and displays
- Strong contrast/lighting throughout the facility
- Accessible signage/information
- Accessible service counters and tables
- Waiting areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters

Washrooms

- Washroom entrance equipped with easy open/automatic door
- Accessible signage identifying Male/Female washrooms
- Lever or automatic taps
- Space under sinks and counter tops for wheelchair access
- Washrooms clear of obstacles such as garbage cans and cleaning supplies
- Sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Coat hooks have lower level access

Parking

- 6 designated accessible parking spaces at front entrance
- 2 designated accessible parking spaces at side of citadel (this door is locked so need to come around to front doors)

Entrance

- Automatic buttons on both double doors

Main Facility

- Meeting rooms are accessible (can be booked, fee schedule available)
- Sanctuary - gradual slope down to front
- Signage for designated wheelchair seating throughout sanctuary (chairs can be removed to provide additional seating)
- Headset available for individuals with hearing impairments
- No automatic button on door of sanctuary

- Accessible washrooms
