Parking

- City parking, pay at meter
- 1 designated parking space across street from café

Entrance

- 1 step at front - portable ramp available upon request
- Double doors, standard width, open out
- Will likely require assistance to get into restaurant if using a wheelchair

Main Facility

- Low lighting
- Chairs can be moved to accommodate wheelchair at table
- Outside patio only accessible by stairs

Washrooms

- Wider stalls in male and female washrooms, not very accessible
- Heavy door with standard knob

- Accessible complimentary parking
- 3 accessible free parking spaces in hotel garage on availability

Entrance

- Main entrance is level and has automatic doors

Washroom

- Accessible stalls in male and female washrooms

- Restaurant is spacious and easily accessible to wheelchair users
- Good colour contrast and natural lighting

- Good colour contrast and lighting

- Main entrance slopes slightly and has a small lip at entrance

Parking

- 2 accessible parking spaces, 1 with sign
- 1 space slightly wider than the other

Entrance

- 2 doors and double set of doors which are heavy
- Threshold at 1st set of doors in high

Main Facility

- Tile flooring
- Tables are very close together - can use wheelchair if chairs are moved
- Bar has hardwood flooring
- High counters and tables

Outdoor Patio

- Accessible through the bar
- Sunken threshold
- Wood deck

Washrooms

- No direct path to washrooms
- Single accessible washroom

- Assistance may be required with double doors at main entrance

Parking

- Street parking for a fee

Entrance

- All signage indicating entrance has been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- Doorway equipped with an automatic button opening features
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair or scooter users
- Exterior ramp has a non-slip finish
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting at the entrance
- Entrance has sufficient lighting

Main Facility

- Smooth/non slip surface
- Accessible elevator access to multilevel areas
- Waiting areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters

Washroom

- Accessible signage identifying Male/Female washrooms
- Light switches, paper towel, hand dryer and soap dispensers with automatic lower level access
- Lever or automatic taps
- Space under sinks and counter tops for wheelchair access
- Washrooms clear of obstacles such as garbage cans, cleaning supplies etc.
- Sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Coat hooks have lower level access
- Mirrors angled for lower level access
- Pull down wall table
- Available single washrooms

Parking

- Street parking available for a fee

Walkway

- All pedestrian routes to each accessible entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Smooth surface to provide easy access by wheelchair
- Flat grade or gradual slope
- Rest stops for longer distances
- Main access routes clear of obstacles such as snow, construction, etc.
- Obstructions and hazards been eliminated from normal pedestrian routes
- All exterior accessible pedestrian route(s) or paths at least 3'-6" (1065mm) wide
- Accessible curb cuts or ramps been provided wherever there is a change in level along pedestrian routes

Entrance

- All signage indicating entrance has been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- All signage indicating entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Doorway equipped with an automatic button, automatic slide, or easy open features
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair, or scooter users
- Ramp has smooth non-slip surface, grade ratio 1:12
- Entrance clear of obstacles such as shoes, snow, mats, etc.
- Exterior ramps and stairs have a non-slip finish

Main Facility

- Smooth/non slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles such as mats, seating, displays, etc.
- Waiting areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters
- Dining room area has comfortable space for wheelchair access

Washrooms

- Washroom entrance equipped with easy open/automatic door (2nd door entrance to washroom is manual access)
- Light switches, paper towel, hand dryer and soap dispensers with automatic lower level access
- Lever or automatic taps
- Space under sinks and counter tops for wheelchair access
- Washrooms clear of obstacles such as garbage cans, cleaning supplies etc.
- Sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Coat hooks have lower level access
- Pull down wall table

- Accessible parking

Walkway

- Gradual slope Small paved ramp at curb

Entrance

- Dim lighting
- Double doors with door handles, slightly heavy

Main Facility

- some tables are close together, chairs and tables may be moved to accommodate wheelchairs
- 2 portable debit machines

Banquet Room

- Open concept, narrow door frame
- Small threshold to access
- Upstairs washroom can only be accessed by stairs

Washrooms

- Accessible stall

- Use backdoor entrance to lower level, this is where washroom is
- Front entrance has small step onto walkway, with heavy double doors

Washrooms

- Washroom is located on lower level and has one step

- Downtown parking
- Closest accessible parking spot is about 50m away at the RBC

Walkway

- Smooth surface to provide easy access by wheelchair
- Flat or gradual slope
- All exterior accessible pedestrian route(s) or paths at least 1065mm wide

Entrance

- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair or scooter users
- Sufficient lighting from windows in the entrance

Main Facility

- Smooth/non-slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles
- Accessible service counters/tables

Washroom #1 – Single Accessible Washroom (with urinal)

- Accessible signage identifying washroom
- Light switches, soap dispensers and door lock with lower level access
- Space under sinks for wheelchair access
- Sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Pull-down changing table
- Available single washroom

Washroom 2 – Accessible Stall

- Larger stall available
- Light switches, paper towel and soap dispensers with lower level access
- Space under sink for wheelchair access
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Pull down changing table
