Parking

- Accessible free parking

Entrance

- Fully accessible main entrance, including automatic doors

Main Facility

- Low service counters at ticket booths
- Wheelchair seating available in all ten theatres
- Wheelchair users plus one companion receive reduced admission with Access 2 Entertainment Card
- Assistive listening devices available

Washrooms

- Fully accessible individual washrooms

Accessible free parking

Entrance

- Accessible entrance off parking lot

Main Facility

- Main facility is spacious
- Small step up to bowling lane area, portable ramp is available
- Portable bowling ball track is available for those unable to throw ball

Washrooms

- Washrooms are small

Parking

- Accessible parking spaces clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- 20 accessible spots available
- Designated accessible parking spaces been provided within 100 feet (30 m) of an accessible entrance
- A safe, clearly marked accessible pedestrian route from the designated parking area to an accessible building entrance or elevator lobby
- Parking surface smooth and flat
- No curbs
- Parking area and route has sufficient lighting

Walkway

- All building and route signage been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- All pedestrian routes to each accessible entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Smooth surface to provide easy access by wheelchair
- Flat grade or gradual slope
- Main access routes clear of obstacles such as snow, construction, etc.
- Obstructions and hazards been eliminated from normal pedestrian routes
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting along walkway
- Flat surface throughout, no change in level along pedestrian routes

Entrance

- All signage indicating entrance has been provided in large, high contrast lettering
- All signage indicating entrance clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Doorway equipped with an automatic button, automatic slide, or easy open features
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair, or scooter users

- Entrance clear of obstacles such as shoes, snow, mats, etc.
- Strong contrast/sufficient lighting at the entrance
- Entrance has sufficient lighting

Main Facility

- Smooth/non slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles such as mats, seating, displays, etc.
- Strong contrast/lighting throughout the facility
- Accessible signage/information
- Accessible service counters/tables etc.
- Accessible elevator access to multilevel areas (staff usage)
- Waiting areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters
- ATM machines and payment terminals have lower level access

Washrooms

- Washroom entrance equipped with easy open/automatic door
- Accessible signage identifying Male/Female washrooms
- Light switches, paper towel, hand dryer and soap dispensers with automatic lower level access
- Lever or automatic taps
- Space under sinks and counter tops for wheelchair access
- Washrooms clear of obstacles such as garbage cans, cleaning supplies etc.
- Sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Coat hooks have lower level access

Notes

- CaptiView - closed caption viewing device for deaf and hard of hearing
- Small ramp to enter level of the screen room
- 4 accessible seating spots in regular theatre room (blue lights indicate accessible seating area); 6 accessible seating spots in IMAX theatre
- May request washroom to be blocked off for use if needed for privacy
- Accessible express ticket kiosk

Parking

- 2 designated parking spaces - city parking lot, fee
- Parking garage at back of theatre (11 accessible spaces total); requires 6 stairs to access ramp into building or to go outside of the garage and around to back of the building; fee
- Street parking in front of Megalos Restaurant

Walkway

- All pedestrian route to each accessible entrance clearly marked
- Smooth surface, flat grade or gradual slope

Entrance

- Accessible main and alternate entrances
- Small lip at doors into lobby

Main Facility

- Box Office has 1 counter which is height adjustable
- TTY machine available Monday - Friday, 12 - 5 pm
- Coat Check has height adjustable counter
- Main Theatre has small lip at entrance
- Accessible seating
- Gradual ramp / no handrail to access seats

Parking

- 14 accessible parking spaces (meters)
Walkway
- Smooth surface and flat grade
- All exterior accessible pedestrian routes are wide

Entrance

- Doorways equipped with automatic button
- Door width and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair and scooter
- All gates are accessible (gates 3 & 4 are on ground level)
- 2 ramps inside; 2 ramps outside; 1 ground level

Main Facility

- Accessible signage / information
- Accessible service counters
- Accessible elevator
- Bar counter height is high
- Tables are high with no chairs
- 4 main accessible seating areas
- Accessible seating on ground and 300 level
- Fire alarms are auditory and visual

Washrooms

- Accessible washrooms
- Lights are motion activated

Parking

- 1 accessible parking space at corner of Princess and Barrie St.

Walkway

- Smooth surface and gradual slope
- All exterior accessible pedestrian routes are wide

Entrance

- Double doors (standard width)
- Low threshold

Main Facility

- Low pile carpet and tile
- Bar tables are high
- Several stairs down to dance floor
- Several stairs up to back bar
- Low lighting and contrast

Washrooms

- Accessible washroom
- Standard door knob and width
