Parking

- 3 designated Accessible parking spaces clearly painted with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Designated accessible parking spaces provided within 100'-0'(30m) of an accessible entrance
- Accessible parking spaces 12'-0"(3660 mm) wide
- A safe, clearly marked accessible pedestrian route from designated parking area onto the curb
- Parking surface is smooth and flat
- Accessible parking does not block curb-cuts

Walkway & Entrance

- All signage indicating entrance has been provided in large, high contrast lettering and marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Doorway equipped with an automatic button
- Door width (901.7mm) and threshold provide easy access for wheelchair users
- Entrance has sufficient lighting

Accessible Washroom

- Available single/family washroom
- Accessible signage identifying Accessible/Male/Female washroom
- Light switches, soap dispensers and coat hook with lower level access
- Lever taps
- Space under sink for wheelchair access and pipes are covered
- Washroom is clear of obstacles allowing for sufficient floor space for turning radius and transfers
- Grab bars secured and reinforced
- Mirror angled for lower level access

Main Facility (Reception Area and Hallways)

- Smooth/non-slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles
- Lighting throughout the facility
- Accessible signage/information
- Waiting areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters
- Debit/Credit machine has a long cord

Examination Room

- 3 accessible examination rooms

- Door width of 838.2mm
- Examination chair swivels left and right and adjustable armrests
- Transfer space width beside chair 736.6mm (left) -812.8mm (right).

Notes

- Staff is experienced interacting with clients who use mobility devices
- Building is new (~1 year) and built with accessibility considerations
