Parking:

- Accessible parking spaces clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility with signs identifying accessible parking within the vicinity
- 10 designated accessible parking spaces. 8 are in the larger parking lot and 2 are available in proximity to the Pavilion
- Accessible parking spaces 12-0' wide
- Safe, clearly marked accessible pedestrian route from designated parking area to accessible entrance and walkways
- Parking surface is smooth and flat with accessible curb cuts
- Accessible parking spots don't block curb-cuts
- Parking area and route has sufficient lighting

Walkways:

- Accessible walkways to waterfront and are clearly marked with the International Symbol of Accessibility
- Smooth surface to provide easy access by wheelchair
- Most routes have a flat grade or gradual slope, however, some accessible routes have steeper slopes
- Main access routes are clear of obstacles and hazards have been eliminated from pedestrian routes
- Many park benches and picnic tables are available throughout the park with space for access for wheelchairs and scooters
- Sufficient lighting along walkways

Washrooms:

- Single accessible washroom available in the Pavilion
 - Washroom entrance equipped with easy-open automatic door
 - Accessible signage identifying accessible washroom
- "Round House" washroom buildings with separate Male/Female washrooms clearly labelled
 - Accessible signage identifying Male/Female washrooms
 - Lever door handle for opening

- **NOTE** - Could not complete the washroom profile at this time as the washrooms are open Victoria Day weekend to Thanksgiving Day weekend.
