- The interior of the fort is wheelchair accessible with the exception of the underground firing chambers, and the upper level exhibit rooms
- Wheelchairs available for use

Washrooms:

- Accessible washroom is stalls in male and female washrooms

Parking:

- Street parking
- Parking area and route has sufficient lighting

Walkway:

- Flat grade or gradual slop
- Handrails on stairs and ramp
- Main access routes are clear of obstacles and hazards are eliminated
- Sufficient lighting along the walkway (Street lighting)
- Exterior pedestrian routes are 2'-6" wide

Entrance:

- Ramp has smooth non-slip surface
- Entrance clear of obstacles
- Doorway equipped with a lever door handle
- Where ramps are provided, sloping sections are no longer than 30' (10m)
- Ramps and stairs have a non-slip finish
- Sufficient lighting at the entrance
- 2 steps in order to access the emergency exit

Main Facility:

- Smooth, non-slip surface
- Aisles clear of obstacles
- Strong lighting throughout the facility
- Areas provide access for wheelchairs and scooters (Doorways are 32" wide and spaces between desks in mock classroom are 30" wide)

Washrooms:

- Available single washroom
- 3 steps to access washroom
- Door width of washroom is 29" and space to access toilet is 22"
- Lever tap with space under the sink/countertop

Notes:

- Tours are usually 1-2 hours
- Must book an appointment for a tour
- Available on Mondays and Wednesdays

- Accessible meter parking on Alfred Street

Entrance:

- Accessible wheelchair entrance with automatic door is located at each entrance to building.
- Elevator on first floor provides access to all three floor.
